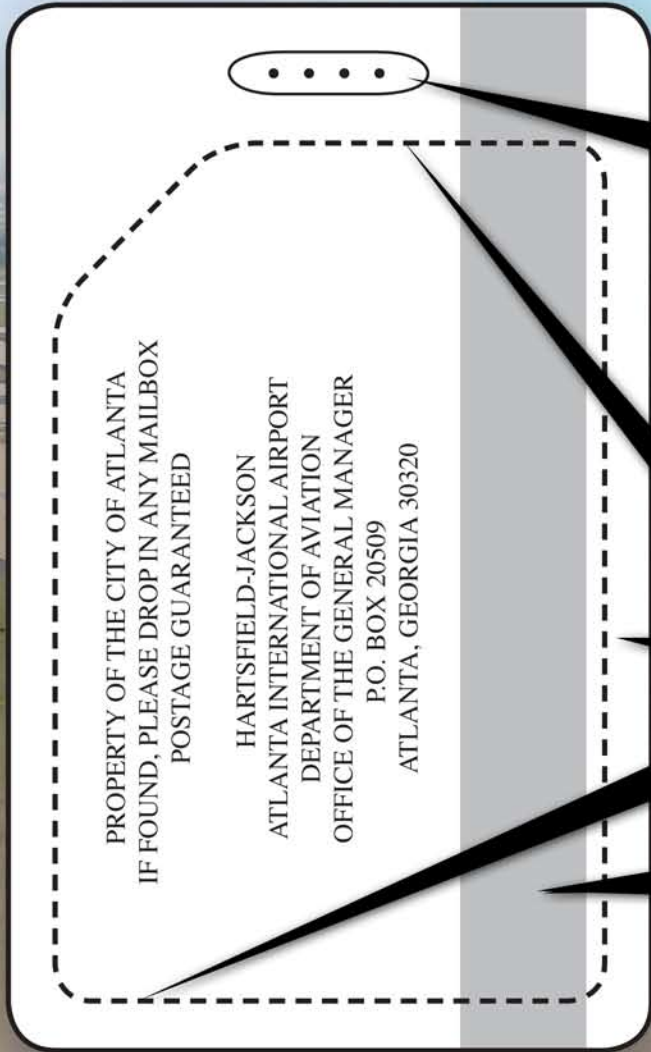


HANDLE CONTACTLESS SMART CARDS PROPERLY TO AVOID DAMAGE



If the reader does not acknowledge your badge with at least one beep, the badge either is broken or has interference from another badge or card with a similar internal antenna, such as a company badge (Delta, AirTran, etc.). Separate it from any other badges or cards and try again.



Hole punch can be made only over the four blue dots at the top of the back of the badge.

Do not leave your badge exposed for an extended period of time to direct sunlight or heat, which can cause it to warp or fade.

The dashed area indicates the internal and hidden chip and antenna loop.

Do not bend or cut the badge, which can break the chip or antenna loop.

The magnetic stripe is no longer used for security access at ATL.
