

# Hartsfield-Jackson Atlanta International Airport

## 2012 Public Art Opportunities

### Project Description

The City of Atlanta Department of Aviation (DOA) invites artists to submit qualifications for a series of public art projects that will be initiated in 2012 at Hartsfield-Jackson Atlanta International Airport. Projects, with estimated budgets ranging from \$100,000 to \$750,000, will be located in pre-existing sites located in the Central Passenger Terminal Complex, the Sky Train Station and the new Maynard H. Jackson International Terminal. The fabrication and installation schedule will be negotiated with the selected artists and will vary depending upon the project proposed.

### Review Process

Submissions will be reviewed by an Artist Review Panel comprised of visual arts professionals and Department of Aviation and City of Atlanta stakeholders. Selected artists will be added to the Airport's Public Art Registry which will be used to develop a short-list of artists for each site. Short-listed artists will be invited to submit a conceptual proposal for their site and will be interviewed by the panel prior to ranking. In select instances short-listed artists may be paid a design fee to develop a more detailed proposal. Recommended artists will be circulated to the leadership of the Department of Aviation and Mayors Office for final approval.

### Submittal Requirements

- *Public Art Statement of Approach & Experience:* include a brief statement outlining your methodology in completing a public art project with examples from past experience. This statement will aid the Review Panel in understanding your approach and better prepare them to match you with an appropriate public art site. (3000 character maximum) Please do not forward specific ideas at this time.
- *Artist Resume:* include a current resume that outlines your professional accomplishments as an artist. (no more than 2 pages)
- *Images of Past Work:* include a CD or DVD (that is PC compatible) with up to fifteen (15) images of artwork completed in the past ten years. The digital files should be jpeg's and be no larger than 5mb each. Name each file with your first initial and last name and number them 1-15 (e.g., JSmith\_image1.jpg). Artists may submit up to two Quicktime media files (up to 45 seconds in length each) if their work is dynamic or interactive. Name each file with your first initial and last name and number them 1-2 (e.g., JSmith\_video1). Please label your CD/DVD with your full name and phone number. Do not send original artwork or photographs.
- *Descriptions of Past Projects:* include a project description sheet that corresponds to your Images of Past Work. Please include project title, budget, project start and completion dates, commissioning entity, location, dimensions and a description that summarizes the project and image.

### Eligibility

All professional artists are eligible to apply but we are especially interested in those with previous public art experience. Artist may submit alone or as a team. The Department of Aviation Art Program encourages artists working in all visual art disciplines to apply, including but not limited to, sculptors, painters, muralists, mosaicists, photographers, videographers, printmakers, animators, light and sound artists, graphic designers, conceptual artists, etc.

### Deadline

All submittals must be received by the DOA Art Program no later than December 30, 2011 to be eligible. Please, forward your materials in advance to ensure they are received by the deadline. Use the appropriate address below depending on how you send in your materials:
